

- 1. It is our policy to support only Independent Baptist missionaries.
- 2. Because a missionary is a church planter and will pastor churches on the field, it is the policy of this church that a missionary must meet the requirements of I Timothy 3 in his personal and public life.
- 3. A missionary will write no less than six times per year except those ministering in a Communist country or who have special circumstances outside of their control.
- 4. Each missionary must be a member of an Independent Baptist Church, and in agreement with the Calvary Baptist Church Doctrinal Statement and Philosophy of Ministry.
- 5. Requests for finances regarding projects and monthly support should be made directly to the pastor of our church. Questions about said support or church policies should be directed to the pastor.
- 6. No missionary may knowingly befriend or support in any way a former member of this church who has been removed from membership by the church due to discipline.
- 7. No missionary should make personal pleas for financial support to any member of the church unbeknownst to the pastor. It is understood that should a missionary change fields, his support by the church will be subject to review. It is understood that should a missionary change his doctrinal position, his support will be dropped immediately, even while he is on the field.
- 8. It is understood that should a missionary change mission boards or home churches, his status for support will be reviewed at that time.
- 9. According to Acts 14-16, missionaries are to be accountable to the local church.
- 10. Any missionary who would argue with the doctrine or philosophy of a supporting church, in our opinion, should not be supported by that church.
- 11. The doctrinal/philosophy position of the missionary/mission board is subject to yearly review and the missionary/missions board will comply with request for such position.
